Reflection:

A few years ago, I was on a short pilgrimage with a group of friends. We took as our theme Growth.

All life begins with a seed which then grows through a stem which transports food water and other elements for life to flourish which then gives incentive to fulfil the potential of the branches, leaves, flowers, fruit to work together to not only produce seed which prolongs the potential but to shelter and feed so much of creation.
