CHURCHYARD WILD FLOWERS ESTABLISHMENT 2020/1

You may have noticed a small bald patch of earth where the roof contractor's rubbish compound was? This presents an ideal opportunity and location to try to establish a wild flower area. This will involve removing any weeds which come up this spring/ summer, then scattering annual, biannual & perennial wild flower seed this autumn. In spring 2021 removing any weeds, followed at the end of the summer (August/September) with a 'hay cut'. The 2021 regime will need to be repeated each year as the annual maintenance programme.

Some orange/yellow Daylilies (Hemerocallis), a gift from one of the church's neighbours, have been planted as a backdrop to this patch. If they successfully settle in they will provide a splash of colour through some of the summer months.
